FIRST AID

If swallowed

- Immediately call a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give any liquid to the person.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing

- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

HAZARDS TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

CAUTION

User Safety Recommendations

Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Wash the outside of gloves before removing.

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DO NOT USE ON CATS. May be toxic or potentially fatal if applied to or ingested by cats. Accidental application to cats and/or grooming a recently treated dog may result in tremors and/or uncoordinated muscle movements. If this occurs, immediate veterinary care should be provided.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees and other pollinating insects exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops and weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees or other pollinating insects are actively visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT USE ON CATS

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. Do not transfer to another container. Application of products on pets must only be done indoors.

CLOTHING:

To repel and kill mosquitoes, chiggers, mites, and Ticks, including Deer Ticks that may carry Lyme disease and Rocky Mountain spotted fever.

This product should be applied directly to clothing, outdoor gear, and shoes and allowed to dry prior to wearing or prior to using in the field. This product must not be applied to clothing while it is being worn. Under no circumstances should this product be applied directly to humans.

- Do not spray directly on or otherwise allow to come into contact with skin, face, or eyes.
- This product is intended to be used on clothing and exterior gear only, such as backpacks, parkas, tents, or bed nets.
- Make all applications outdoors in a well-ventilated area.

For up to six-week protection against Ticks, Chiggers, mites, and mosquitoes apply the product to articles outdoors under conditions free from wind.

- Spray outer surfaces only, while either hanging or on a flat surface. Use a sweeping motion to ensure the entire surface of the fabric is covered maintaining a distance of 6-8 inches from the surface of the fabric.
- Treat the front, back, and sides of the outfit or other outdoor textile and allow to dry for at least 2 hours. It is important to concentrate on areas the pest may seek to enter your clothing such as, socks, bottoms of trousers, and cuffs. You may repeat these directions after six weeks of use.

One bottle will treat 7 full outfits. Use 4.5 ounces per outfit, approximately 1/7 of the bottle. The treatment should wet the fabric enough to notice a color change as if the article was wet with water.

It has been shown through field experience that further tick and flea prevention can be achieved by sealing the bottoms of trousers using tape or by tucking into socks.

For further protection, use in conjunction with an USEPA approved insect repellent registered for direct application to the skin and utilize the following primary preventive measures. Avoid walking in areas where the pests are found, wear appropriate protective clothing (light-colored, long-sleeved shirt and long pants tucked into socks) and inspect body daily for ticks.

MOSQUITO NETS, TENTS, SLEEPING BAGS, BACKPACKS, SCREENS, CAMPING LOUNGES, SLEEPING PADS AND TENT FOOTPRINTS:

- Only treat outsides of products.
- Do not treat surfaces which come in direct contact with skin. Spray outdoors or in a well-ventilated area when wind is calm.
- Either hang or lay out gear so areas to be treated are easily accessible. Spray maintaining a distance of 6-8 inches and treat all exterior areas of fabric.
- Continue spraying until surfaces are moist and allow at least 2 hours to dry prior to use.
- Do not treat more than once every six weeks.

ON DOGS

ON DOGS to control fleas, ticks and lice; start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and underbody. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Use protective gloves (mitts) to prevent contact with hands. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes or face; Avoid contact with genitalia.

NOTE: Do not use on animals under 12 weeks of age.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: if empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.

If partly filled: Do not pour or dispose down-the-drain or sewer. Call your local solid waste Agency for local disposal options.
